Six tips for tip-top photos

1. Take your photos landscape instead of portrait.
2. Make sure your surroundings are well-lit, but try not to aim the camera directly at a window or the sun. Face away instead and your picture will be nice and bright.
3. Try to keep your hands still!
4. Take a few photos so you can choose the best one.
5. If you're with someone who has a better phone or camera than you, ask them to take the photo and send it to you.

Capture your Crafternoon on video

1. Film facing away from a window to avoid a shadowy video.
2. Don't worry about background noise, the main thing is capturing the action!
3. Try not to move the camera or phone around too quickly, slow movements are best.
