



## The Great Crafty Cake Off

Everyone loves a bake off, and it's also a great way to get your guests to bring along some refreshments!

Here's how you can take part in the Great Crafty Cake Off 2018...

**Step one:** Set the date of your Crafternoon and ask your guests to bake something delicious for the day. You can choose a theme like cakes or cookies to make it easier to settle on recipes – or you can leave it up to imagination.

**Step two:** Get your prizes ready for the winners. Lots of local businesses are willing to donate prizes for charity events, and we can give you a fundraising confirmation letter to show them too (just email the team on [crafternoon@mind.org.uk](mailto:crafternoon@mind.org.uk)).

**Step three:** It's time for your Crafternoon! Ask for a donation on the day to take part in the bake off, we recommend £5 per bake. Make sure to keep a list of ingredients and label everything in case anyone is allergic to something. Visit [food.gov.uk](http://food.gov.uk) if you're unsure.

**Step four:** Let the judging commence. Be the judge yourself or get a few of your non-participating guests to do the honours. Try a bit of everything and award your prizes.
