Share your QR code for a quick and easy way for people to find and donate to your fundraising page.

## What is a QR code?

A QR code (quick response code) is a small black and white square barcode that you can scan with your camera and be taken straight to your fundraising page.

It's great to use on posters around the office and community. It allows people to easily find your fundraising page without having to share the link or type out the web address.

## How to find your QR code

Simply add '**/qrcode'** to the end of fundraising page URL (link) and click enter.

For example, www.justgiving.com/ fundraising/GeorgesBrighton Marathon**/qrcode** 

You can then screenshot your QR code so you always have it to hand, as well as adding it to posters.
