About the role

The Network Quality Team at Mind are looking for four individuals with lived experience of mental health problems to help judge the Mind Network Excellence Awards 2021. Each judge will score nominations for the 14 award categories.

What are the Mind Network Excellence Awards?

The Mind Network Excellence Awards celebrate the best in the local Mind network. The awards highlight the wealth of expertise and innovation in local Minds. The 2019 and 2020 awards demonstrated the breath-taking dedication there is to support those with mental health problems helping make a profound difference to their lives. We know that those entering the 2021 awards will be no different.

In this role you will...

- assess nominations using our scoring criteria
- use Flexigrant (an online platform) to read and assess the nominations
- be given remote training (on Thursday 15th July) before you get started with the judging

- be able to do everything from home, so the current Covid-19 situation will not affect this opportunity (we are available for any questions on this)





You will need to be available for the **first two weeks of August** to be able to take on this role.

Deadline for applications: Sunday 6th June 12pm

There will be no interview stage for this opportunity.

What to expect from us:

- Training on the platforms that will be used (Flexigrant/Zoom)

- Remuneration of £100 per day for up to 3 days (anticipated time commitment for the training, reading and feedback)

- Support and guidance throughout

This is a great opportunity to get involved with some really exciting work!

Selection criteria:

- Lived experience of mental health problems and of using mental health services (not necessarily Mind's services)

- Confident in computer/IT skills (using emails, opening documents, using Word and the internet, confident using new platforms)

- Ability to read applications and apply judging criteria

- Have access to a computer/laptop with internet
